Description:

Little Angel Theatre is a former temperance hall that was converted into a puppet theatre in 1961. The auditorium, foyer and toilets are all on one floor, which is at street level.

The auditorium seats 100 people (bench seating) and ushers monitor the number of people in the auditorium. Ushers monitor the audience during the show in case of emergencies and assist with evacuation.

The auditorium has a raised wooden stage with a cavity underneath. White lines are painted onto the ends of the stage to distinguish edges and scenery is does not jut over the stage edge.

Wheelchair space is provided in the auditorium. There is a small (5cm) step up to the foyer from the street that can easily be climbed by a manual wheelchair, for electric wheelchairs a ramp can be used.

Fire exits are located at the back of the auditorium and backstage. All staff are trained in evacuation and fire procedures.

Fire extinguishers are located at strategic points around the building.

Audience members can buy snacks (including sweets and biscuits) and cold drinks. Tea and coffee are also served. No food or drink may be taken into the auditorium except for cold water.

There are separate male, female and disabled toilet cubicles. Baby changing facilities are provided.

The entire building is a designated No Smoking zone.
